Input sought on downsizing Legislature, extending terms

Erie County Executive Chris Collins has set a Wednesday hearing to record public comments on a proposed law to shrink the Legislature from 15 members to 13 while extending the length of a term from two years to four. The hearing will be held at 1 p. m. on the 14th floor of the Rath County Office Building, 95 Franklin St.

The questions will have to go before voters this November. However, Collins has promised to veto the law unless the Legislature lets voters decide each change separately.
